PARISH COUNCIL NOTES from the Chairman

1. **Gypsy/Traveller Site Planning Application PK17/2008/F** – A legal challenge by the Tormarton Action Group has led to the planning decision made in January being quashed. A new report is now being prepared and this will be considered at the South Glos Council Planning Committee meeting on the 23rd August. This report will appear on the Council's website 5 working days before the meeting and we understand that there will be no consultation.
2. **Tormarton Village Website** - Did you know, Tormarton has its very own Village Website? It can be found at www.tormarton.org - looked after by Simon Stevens who took over its running in May this year from Alan Creighton. Please do have a look at the information already available, and contact Simon on admin@tormarton.org if you have ideas for information or new pages that you would like to see on the website in the future. He would especially like to hear about local businesses, clubs, or special interest groups that you would like to see included there. There are already plans to add a simple village message board for small ads, and of course you can already send details of local events and public notices to Simon that you would like him to highlight. Speeding on the Acton Turville Road.

There are numerous daily cases of speeding along the Acton Turville Road. This is really dangerous for all those trying to walk along to get to the Cotswold Way or The Compass Inn. Also, anyone trying to pull out onto the road from the village or living along this road seems particularly vulnerable to these drivers. This has been reported at certain times by calling 101 and going through to the transport police. The police have suggested that the more times this is logged the better as it will become an increasing priority. *If anyone sees speeding or dangerous driving along the road we would be most grateful if they could call 101 to log the issue and improve the safety of our village.*
