Letter from the ministry team - Jean Purnell (Former LPA)

Life is busy, especially during May 2023. We have the coronation of King Charles III, several bank holidays, school exams start, the garden needs attention, and the events calendar fills up eg May Fair. Everything starts to happen again now that longer sunny and dry days emerge, as does the new growth and leaves open on the trees.

Marshfield Church planted an oak tree in February as part of Queen Elizabeth II's green canopy. The oak is often called the king of trees and our focus turns from his mother towards King Charles for his coronation, being crowned now in May.

As Christians we have just experienced again the season of Easter. We think of Jesus on Good Friday hanging on the Cross with the crown of thorns. That Cross we understand was made of wood and the thorns would have come from a bush/tree. Jesus crucified to give us new Life on a tree.

The original tree of Life is the one in the garden of Eden. Adam and Eve were separated from God and the source of life by eating the fruit of a forbidden tree, the Tree of the Knowledge of Good and Evil. The Good Friday cross is the redemptive Tree of Life which brings us all into God's presence again, only achieved by that tree being the cross of death and suffering for Jesus.

Lord of resurrection Life Be known through our lives and through your power, The risen Lord of Life.



Christian Aid Week 2023 14th-20th May

This year, the focus of CAW is on Malawi, where soaring costs of food and essentials are crushing dreams and keeping people in poverty. Children are robbed of schooling when their parents can't pay the fees. Farmers are struggling to survive in the face of the climate crisis and its threats of devastating droughts, floods and storms. Christian Aid has

worked in Malawi for 20 years, empowering vulnerable communities to escape poverty by giving them the skills to:

- Grow crops that are more resilient to the climate crisis
- · Restore soil fertility and increase harvests
- Learn business skills
- Join cooperatives to earn more for their crops
