Becoming Like Christ

To become like Christ may seem quite presumptuous. Surely we can't be like the Son of God, he was completely unique and perfect, wasn't he? He had all the Christmas angels announcing when he came, and we hardly expect that for us! Yet there are several places in Scripture where we are encouraged to aim for just that, to be like Jesus. Consider first how in John 20 Jesus said "as the Father has sent me, I am sending you". We are supposed to be sent in the same way as Jesus. How was that? At Christmas we remember how God gave Jesus in a weak and vulnerable form, not as some powerful ruler. He came in poverty to bring interior riches. Maybe we can learn how strength, image, influence are not necessarily our pattern for action, but rather personal, open-hearted action.

Then Paul tells in his letter to the Philippians of how we should "have the same mindset as Christ Jesus", when Jesus was not counting equality with God something to be used or held on to, but took the form of a servant. I do often wonder whether loving service is actually the central Christian ethic, not any of our other activities. Serving would certainly be Christlike – remember the disciples' foot washing? Paul also in the same letter wanted to become "like [Christ] in his death", and through that to know his own resurrection. So it's not just service, but sacrificial service – work that costs us something, for which we have to give up our status, comfort, what else? – to "lose our lives" as Jesus himself said – to which we need to aspire.

While it is true that John wrote that we shall only be fully like Christ when he finally appears again, yet we are clearly meant to follow Jesus' example and seek Jesus' qualities in our lives here and now. How might that work out in our daily lives? We can perhaps view our situations as areas where God has placed us to be like Christ, to bring something of Jesus' character into those groups or places. We might be the person who speaks that word, or who says that silent prayer, that only we are in a position to give. We may feel unworthy (and in fact we are) but if His life in us is allowed to take root, then it will be His life that is shown as we seek to be more like Christ. We can ask ourselves when faced with a decision, or when given the opportunity to serve: "what would be Christlike in this situation?".

We shall be singing soon as part of one of the well known carols "Be born in us today" – may the reality of that life in us make us more like Christ, bit by bit, character trait by character trait, day by day.
