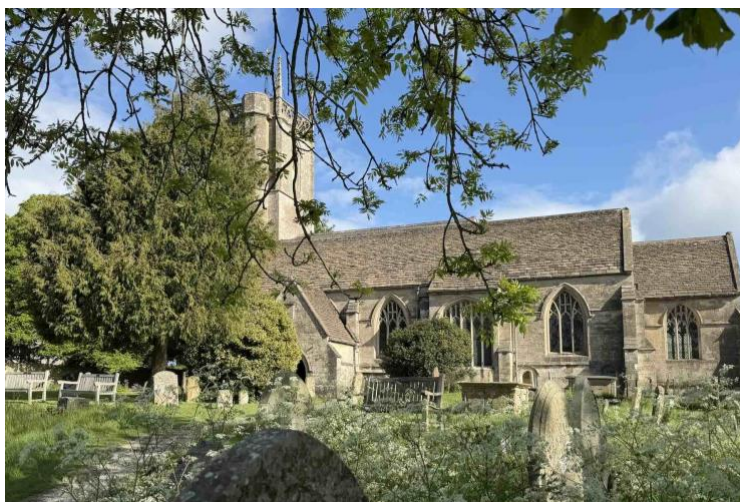
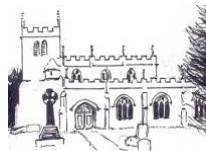
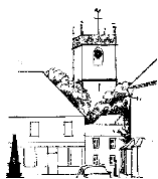

Cotswold Edge Ministry Team Letter

150 years of Love in Action

It was in 1876, 150 years ago, that Mary Sumner, a Vicar's wife in Winchester Diocese and a grandmother recognised the need for young mothers to have some guidance in bringing up their children. A group of women in their parish were invited to the vicarage for the first meeting and the movement grew from that small beginning into an international charity. Caring for families was central to the work of this charity as was the belief that prayer was an essential part of transforming lives. MU members are encouraged to pray for the work of MU every day. Today, there are four million members in 84 countries helping communities to transform their lives for the better by working to combat poverty, injustice and violence.

There is a lot to celebrate when we look back over the years and see how women's lives have been changed for the better by the work done by MU members in their local communities. In Bristol, MU members are involved in many projects – supporting parents who spend time with their children in the Bristol Children's Hospital; welcoming visitors to Ashfield Prison; supporting the homeless and a women's night shelter in Bristol; recently we have started to support a project in Swindon feeding the homeless. Every summer we provide coaches to take families to Weston-super-Mare so children get a day at the seaside. As well as helping to fund all these activities we join with MU members all over Britain and Ireland campaigning against gender-based violence, domestic abuse and modern slavery. MU has a voice at the United Nations and also lobbies the government to make changes.

Despite the name, membership is not limited to 'mothers' – the charity now welcomes single women, men as well as women and divorce is no longer a barrier to membership. Mothers' Union is just one way that Christians can act out their faith in loving service to others, alongside the other charities that we support, e.g. The Ripple Effect. This year I would just like everyone to celebrate this grassroot organisation which has been helping to improve women's lives all over the world for 150 years. What started as one woman's vision to support parenting has grown into a mass global movement bringing sustainable change, and seeking a future in which everyone can thrive.
